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

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

Nothing pushes the boundaries of motorsport more than the quest for the fastest lap. It's the ultimate ambition for drivers, engineers and teams as well as the purest measure of out-andout performance.

To achieve this holy grail of competition, everything has to work in perfect harmony. And when it all comes together, posting a time that's quicker than the rest is a feeling like no other.

Time Attack manifests this pursuit of perfection more than any other form of motorsport. Its unique format challenges drivers to set the best lap time achievable - and then do it again!

EVENT FORMAT

Each event features four, carefully conceived and clearly defined sessions of between 15 and 20 minutes:

Warm-up: This opening encounter provides the opportunity for drivers to execute a series of installation laps, enabling them to get familiar with the car, circuit and conditions. After the session, the data collected enables teams to make adjustments and set-up their cars accordingly.

Practice: This is where things step up a notch and when the timing screens revealing who's on it and who's not. And whilst there are no championship points or awards up for grabs in this session, it's still possible to claim a class lap record – so the gloves are off!

Qualifying: Championship points are awarded in this session, which means drivers set their sights on one thing and one thing only: the lap time. It's also the last chance to get the car, tyres and mental focus dialled in before the Final session.

Final: The times in the final session dictate the event results and the greater provision of points. It's where teams and drivers bring together everything they've learned from the previous three sessions, strategically plan their run to correspond with track conditions and make sure everything is wound to the limit in order to deliver that perfect lap.

Adding to the mix are competitors making a one-off appearance, or those who choose to compete in selected events. While not registered for the championship and therefore ineligible to score points, competitors battle it out between themselves to be the fastest Single Round Entry driver of the day in each of the classes, bringing yet another exciting element that gives Time Attack its unique appeal.

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CARS & CLASSES

The classing structure and the regulations that define the specification of the cars within each class has been developed using years of experience and lap time data. Cars range from almost standard examples with the required amount of safety equipment fitted, to 1000+hp race-spec monsters that represent the ultimate in performance tuning and engineering.

All cars must be based on a production model and competitors have to disclose the modifications carried out. Throughout the season, lap-times are monitored and where necessary, adjustments are made to ensure fair competition is maintained across the classes; the quicker the car, the further up the classing structure it goes.

The classes are split into three sessions based on performance:

Session 1

Clubman:	Cars that are 25 years or older Road and track day cars with few modifications Smaller engined cars & hot hatche
Session 2	
Club 2WD:	Two-wheel-drive modified cars
Club 4WD:	Four-wheel-drive modified cars
Session 3	

Club Pro:	Highly-tuned race-spec cars running on treaded tyres

SINGLE ROUND ENTRIES

THE BACKSTORY


Time Attack originated in Japan during the 1980s, when rival tuners battled it out for supremacy. Initially on public roads, as power and performance increased it wasn't long before the competition moved onto the track, with the now legendary Tsukuba Circuit near Tokyo the first venue to hoist this new-found motorsport discipline.

It was here tuners were able to prove they could design and build the quickest car, not just on the straights but around corners too. With mechanical and aero modifications developed to achieve the fastest way around the circuit, it was never about racing and all about the lap time. And so, Time Attack was born.

The UK Time Attack Championship was introduced in 2006 by the people who still own and operate it today. In 2010 Time Attack was formally recognised by Motorsport UK (Britain's governing body for motorsport), with the association publishing specific rules and formats in its national regulations. Each season typically comprises eight rounds at the nation's leading race circuits, including all five operated by MotorSport Vision. Supported by a series of wellestablished and hugely popular car shows, Time Attack events now represent some of the biggest national motorsport occasions in the UK.

Currently enjoying its 19th consecutive season in 2024, the championship continues to attract drivers and teams from all corners of the UK as well as overseas, presenting an eclectic mix of cars that many of the 1000s of spectators and on-line followers the championship can readily relate to. In fact, such has been its success, the UK Championship has gone on to become the largest and most professional Time Attack package in the world. With mechanical and aero modifications developed to achieve the fastest way around the circuit, it was never about racing and all about the lap time. And so, Time Attack was born.



MOTORSPORT UK DRIFT PRO CHAMPIONSHIP ROUND 6

We are excited to present Round 6 of this year's Motorsport UK Drift Pro Championship - the highest status Drift competition this country has ever seen.

The first two rounds in April at Anglesey Circuit saw Dave Bastin's Kent Models Toyota AE86 win Round 1, and reigning champion Lwi Edwards' Bilstein BMW take Round 2. In May, Round 3 moved to the challenging Cadwell Park, where Lwi Edwards triumphed again, mastering the track's unforgiving twists and turns.

Round 4 at Brands Hatch in June saw the championship leaderboard shaken up as Ian Phillips claimed his first ever victory, stepping onto the top of the podium in the Tegiwa Racing 350Z.

Round 5 electrified Oulton Park in July, with a bright, sunny day offering a stark contrast to the wet conditions of 2023. The dry circuit presented its own challenges, as drivers had to adapt to the layout while unleashing the full power of their machines. Championship leader Lwi Edwards faced an early exit after a crash abruptly ended his day, while Paul Cunnington made a triumphant return to the podium, clinching 1st place after a tough season.

With the championship battle now tighter than ever and 20 drivers on the grid for Round 6, anything could happen next!

DRIFTING ON ANOTHER LEVEL

Before 2021, a fully accredited and officially acknowledged Drifting competition had never been held in the UK. But in a move that defines the top-tier of the sport in Britain and sets out a road map for its future, an innovative collaboration between Motorsport UK (the sport's governing body) and the Time Attack Organisation inspired the development and creation of the Motorsport UK Drift Pro Championship.

WILDCARD ENTRIES

To keep the competition fierce and add even more interest into the mix, 2024 sees the introduction of Wildcard entries, where drivers who are not registered for the championship can jump in for a single round. Whilst their results won't count towards championship points or positions, they will compete to be the best of the rest, with an award presented to the highestfinishing Wildcard driver.

Before the competition begins and to ensure they know exactly what the competitors are up against, all of the judges will drift-drive the course. Consequently, drivers and fans can have absolute confidence that the decisions made and the scores applied will be based on real-life experience and first-hand knowledge.

During the tandem battle portion of the competition, the judges will independently determine a winner by comparing the lead runs of both drivers, as well as the chase runs of both drivers during each battle.

Qualifying

The judging criteria for gualifying will be a combination of the following:

- Speed
- Angle of drift
- Line (line is designated by clipping points, outside zones and touch & go areas)







TANDEM BATTLES

The judging criteria for tandem competition is:

- Lead driver's line, angle and style
- Chase driver's ability to mirror the lead driver's line, angle, speed and style

FIFTHGEAR

TAKATA

Chase driver's proximity to the lead driver

The judges will look for which driver performs better in the tandem battle in both run 1 and run 2, comparing both lead runs to each other another and both chase runs to each other to determine which driver won in each position.

Scores will be calculated from a maximum total of 100 points, as follows:

Line: 40 pts Angle: 30 pts Style: 20 pts Speed: 10pts

Line scores will be based on a driver's ability to adhere to the line stipulated by the Judges during the driver's briefings. Points will be allocated for outside zones and inner clips, but may also be allocated to zones. Points will be deducted as follows:

- One wheel off the track: 2 points deducted for each offence.
- Two wheels off the track: 5 points deducted for each offence.
- Three wheels off the track: 10 points deducted for the first offence. If repeated during the same run, zero Line points will be awarded for that run
- Four wheel off the track: Zero points
- Further deductions will be made for missing clipping points and partially filling zones.

Angle scores will be judged on a driver's ability to achieve and maintain a high level of angle, as described by the Judges during the driver's briefings. Points will be deducted for the following:

Lack of angle Corrections Double-initiation

Style & speed scores will be judged on commitment and fluidity, initiation speed and average speed throughout the run. Points will be deducted for the following:

- Off or partial throttle prior to initiation
- Initiating beyond latest initiation point
- Slowing outside deceleration zones
- Timid approach
- Slow rotations
- Stepped rotations (steering to add small amounts of angle at a time)
- Inaccurate rotations (achieving degree of angle,
 - then adding or subtracting angle)

IE ACTION! The Drift competition sees cars start from the race grid, head around turn one at Old Hall Corner before dropping down the Avenue, accelerating through Dentons and Cascades where they'll initiate at speeds that defy the laws of physics. Switching angles, they'll launch into the right, right, left and right of Fosters, Hislops

and Knickerbrook before crossing the finish line

at the foot of Clay Hill. And breathe...

There are plenty of places on either side of the track where you can watch the action. Just take a look at the map and pick your vantage point.

Wherever you choose to watch, don't miss what promises to be some of the best Drifting action vou've ever seen!

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THE JUDGES

Deciding on the outcome of the competition are the Judges. That's why we have invited some of the best in the business to join us for the inaugural season of the Motorsport UK Drift Pro Championship:

JULIAN SMITH

A relatively new name to the judging tower but not a new name in the sport is Julian Smith, owner of Garage-D; one of Europe's best known performance centres for Japanese Street, Drift and Circuit cars.

Julian has been involved with Drifting in the UK from its beginnings in the early 2000s and has done most, if not everything you could imagine involving the sport: from teaching Tiff Needell to drift for the 5th Gear TV programme in 2006, to building the Driftworks Nissan S15 that dominated BDC in 2010.



LRIET PRO-

TYLER KELLY

Tyler is another with a long and successful history in Drfiting and has been involved with the UK scene for nearly 16 years. However, his path in the sport has been somewhat different, as he started his Drift career'spotting' for drivers, his skill in being able to convey information earning him a welldeserved reputation.

Working alongside many of the UK's top drivers – Tyler's input in providing guidance and advice has helped many to achieve great success at home and overseas. He has also judged other championships in the past, which makes him an ideal candidate to join the Motorsport UK Drift Pro team this weekend.

MASAYA YUMEDA

Masaya (Maz) has been involved in UK Drift scene since 2005, when he performed duties as a judge and commentator at major Drift competitions, including providing commentary at D1 exhibition events in both the UK and USA. In more recent times, you may have seen and heard him as the voice of the UK Time Attack Championship.

Masaya has been deeply involved in the Japanese car tuning and aftermarket scene through his involvement with a variety of events and also through his day job at HKS Europe, the UK based subsidiary of the legendary Japanese

tuning parts manufacturer where he is Managing Director.

COMMENTATOR - FRASER MACAULAY

Fraser Macaulay has an encylopedic knowledge of the drifting world,, particularly the so-called classic Japanese 'Golden Era' of the early D1 and D1SL days, Option Magazine, Hot Version plus endless obscure JDM only racing game titles. Combining this depth of experience and the modern competition scene makes him one of the best people to lead you and the audiences through what's going on, and why.

Fraser hails from Aberdeen Scotland, and has lived and breathed the drifting and motorsports scene since he could drive. He knows how to arrive in style and has owned a fleet of VIP JDM vehicles because that's just how he does it. Fraser looks forward to screaming at high pitch when it all gets exciting.

EVENT FORMAT

Each MSUK Drift Pro Championship event consists of four specific sessions:



PRACTICE

This session provides drivers with an opportunity to familiarise themselves with the circuit and conditions out on track, whilst also ensuring their cars are performing at their best and ready for competition.

QUALIFYING

Drivers will have two opportunities (two runs) to set their qualifying score with the aim of making it into the top 16 and therefore, progress to the Semi-Final. Each judge will score out of 100, take an average and then allocate the score for that run. The points from each driver's best run determines who makes the cut.


THE TOP 16 (semi-final)

This is where the tandem battles start, with each pair battling over two non-consecutive runs. One driver takes the 'lead' on the first run whilst the other driver'chases' them. These roles are then reversed for the second run, allowing both drivers an opportunity to lead and chase. The judges will determine the winner of each battle after both runs have been completed. Just eight drivers will make it through to the final session.

THE TOP 8 (final)

Now the pressure really mounts up! The Top 8 drivers are once again paired into 'battles' with the winner of each progressing through to a final show down.

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

Title race hots up at **Donington Park**

Donington Park could play a crucial role in the outcome of the Racing Hondas Championship's three classes and its outright title, writes Carl McKellar.

The closely matched Dan Brown (Civic Bali) and Liam Collins (supercharged Integra DC2) lead the way in Class A for the championship's more powerful 'prototype' cars and they are expected to be out in front again on Donington's National circuit.



It's Brown 6, Collins 3 in terms of outright race wins with just nine points between them at the top of the Class A table. Both know the importance of scoring well with just Brands Hatch's and Snetterton's four rounds to go after Sunday's action...

Meanwhile Ryan Jenkinson (on a high after his win last time out at Oulton Park), James Allen, Will Murfin, Kevin Talbot, Rich Hockley and, if his rotten luck improves finally, 2023 champion Phil Wright are all podium contenders.

Watch, too, for Donington local Oliver Barsby's stunning new Civic FK2 - expected to make its debut here following a major build project.

Class B is also on a knife edge. Alfie Jeakins has led the standings all season but nearest challenger Tommy Knight still has him in his sights. Nick Charlier, Loui Hounsell, Andy Wheatley and, with three wins in just four races, latecomer Dave Buky are all capable of stealing away valuable points.

Although ineligible to score, 'one-off' entries Jake Hewlett and Paul Taylor should also be in the mix as at Oulton... On current form, though, the Class C and outright titles are surely going the way of Ryan Cunningham. Eight class wins from 10 rounds have put him way clear in both standings and it would take a bizarre twist to deny him.



That's not to say others won't stop trying, though. Sam Linssner and, at Oulton, David Lawrence have managed to inflict rare defeats on him and Spencer Fortag and Ed Sibbald are never far away either.


